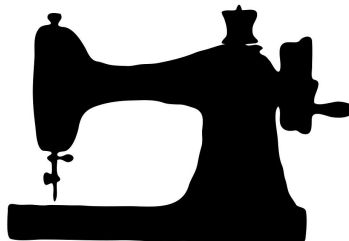
Who?

Quilting is a passion of mine and I'm excited to share my knowledge with your son/daughter. We will be learning many different skills starting with the basics of sewing and progressing from there.

- Your son/daughter will be working with sewing machines, scissors, irons, and pins. These supplies may cause injury if used incorrectly, so it is important for students to follow directions and pay close attention when using these supplies. Also, we have ten brand new Brother sewing machines that students will be able to use, but they need to be treated with care and respect.
- There are many different supplies needed for sewing/quilting. If your child wants to bring in their own fabric, sewing machines, or other supplies they are more than welcome to but it is not necessary as I will provide everything they need.
