

# Confirmation Covenant

*A covenant is a binding agreement or contract. God made covenants with Noah, Abraham, and David, among others. Jesus is the fulfillment of a new covenant between God and His people.*

*The purpose of this Confirmation Covenant is to make parents and students aware of the expectations of Confirmation. We want to give you opportunities to worship, grow, and serve. As you get ready to be confirmed you will be better equipped to excel and continue in these areas. Please don't take this covenant lightly as Confirmation is not something you just do. We hope to make it a life changing experience as the student grows to own and confirm their faith in our awesome God!*

**-Attendance.** We understand that it is important to be at each Confirmation class. We will try to make this a priority and be on time (ready to go at 3:30 p.m.) for each Confirmation class.

**-Prepared.** We understand that it's important to be prepared. Each week we will bring a Bible, Catechism, and Confirmation Folder.

**-Worship.** We understand that regular worship is important. We will attend church regularly.

**-Family Time.** We understand that there will be a Family Time assignment each week. These assignments will need to be turned in on a weekly basis. We will make this a priority each week as we sit down to discuss issues of faith. (Each lesson should take no longer than 20 min) We know that the family is the biggest model and influencer of faith so we will take this seriously. These will need to be signed by a parent each week. If you miss a week no need to worry everything is in your Confirmation Notebook.

**-Service Hours.** We understand that during the year there are 16 hours of service hours required. 8 should be in the Hephatha Lutheran Church community and 8 to be in the community. Examples are provided in the Confirmation 101 sheet in the Parent Packet. The purpose of these are to; 1) Be the body and use your gifts and talents to build up the Church, 2) Find ways to use your gifts and passion to serve the people that live in your neighborhood, city or world. This will need to be recorded on the Service Hours Form, signed by the supervisor (not a parent, unless there was no direct supervisor) and turned in.

**-Forms and Lessons.** Complete all paperwork and stay up-to-date with memory work, family time, and be actively involved in the class.
