Hello Parents!

As we write this letter, we are very excited to begin another year of Confirmation. The Confirmation experience is a time when your child can grow in their faith and, at the end of the two years, have a chance to publicly “confirm” their faith as a follower of Jesus Christ and their desire to become a member of the church, which will happen on Palm Sunday, March 25, 2018 during our 11:00 a.m. service, with First Communion on Thursday, March 29, 2018.

We’ll go over the expectations and requirements for Confirmation, the format of what we do each week, *why* we do it, *how* we do it, and *when* we do it. Please bring your questions and plan on attending this meeting so you can know what to expect as a parent!

Registration Deadline: Wednesday, September 20

We need to know if your child will be part of the Confirmation program so we can put them in a group. There is a \$35 fee for the year which includes a notebook, *The Case for Christ Student Edition*, and all necessary supplies for the year, plus a \$15 fee for *Luther’s Small Catechism* if needed. Included is the registration form that needs to be filled out and returned to the church office by September 20.

First Day of Confirmation: Wednesday, September 20 at 3:30 p.m. – Sanctuary

Please, have your student(s) on time and ready to go at 3:30 p.m. It’s always a little crazy on the first day. They will need to bring *Luther’s Small Catechism*, if they have one, and their favorite Bible. The NIV or ESV translation is best. If they don’t have one let us know and we can get them one.
